The CSSC has incorporated all of the comments that were identified at the last WFEC meeting as well as on subsequent conference calls. The Next Steps has been re-written and will be reviewed. Outcome:

- 2. Approval of Next Steps section

Key Points:

- Next steps portion of the Phase 2 Report was reviewed by the federal agencies and an alternative was developed to the current document Next Steps.
- Rational for the proposed change is to provide consistency in level of detail and to provide flexibility as we develop and learn from our current state of knowledge.
- There is an inequity in the level of detail outlined in the 5 bullets of the next steps which may demonstrate that one is more important than the other.
- From the NGA we want to see more of the detail and action related to the next steps.
- We should not refer them to read another 50 pages in the report without giving a summary
- The Phase III Report may need to be submitted by December of 2012. We need to take time to provide more outreach and collaborative engagement. There are other strong drivers that may result in a more accelerated report. This may be determined through OMB review and discussions in January.
- Page 15 format must change to increase flow
- Page 24 "Trends and Uncertainties..." Land parcelation should be added to the bullets
- Next Steps Proposal was accepted with modification to page 46-49: 5 roman numerals remain the same; red text will be moved to science section; blue text to before the roman numerals to

- Recommended time line was approved with the addition of the WFLC conference call on January 11 and the Phase III recommendations to the Secretary of Interior and Agriculture by February 2013.
- Page 49 change Implementation Plan to Action Plan. (Responsibilities and Timelines)
- On page 24 under Trends and Uncertainties add "Land Parcelization"
