

National Fire Plan Fire Fighting Resources Montana 2002



Lincoln Ranger District Fire Warehouse

The Helena National Forest recently completed construction of the new Lincoln fire warehouse. This was a “backlog” facilities project funded through the National Fire Plan. Construction was completed in 2002. The 100 ft. by 32 ft. multipurpose building meets the needs of local fire management operations and includes a basic layout of two primary rooms.



The new engine bay with two garage doors is big enough to house two engines at one end of the building. This bay is insulated to protect the equipment from freezing and has a shop area, fire cache, and is utilized as a work area for various projects.

The other half of the building is multipurpose as well, providing crew support and a training and meeting area. It includes crew storage, restrooms, laundry, and simple cooking facilities. It also has a workout area with weights and aerobic equipment for physical training.
