The Domingo Shred Project is on the Calaveras Ranger District where 445 acres of vegetation were treated within the wildland urban interface. The area burned in 1992 during the 17,386 acre Old Gulch fire. This fire burned 170 structures and threatened the towns of Avery and Hathaway Pines, which are adjacent to the project area. A private contractor used a track-mounted shredder to thin reproduction and reduce brush and slash within these 10-year old plantations. The result is reduced resistance to control in the advent of future wildfires and increased firefighter safety.
