Subject: IQCS Rebaseline

Introduction/Background:

The Incident Qualifications and Certification System (IQCS) is an information system that tracks training and certifications for wildland firefighters. IQCS is an interagency application that allows for the sharing of wildland firefighter training and certification data across all involved agencies (BLM, NPS, BIA, FWS, and the USFS).

IQCS requires an approved Rebaseline to include DOI Office of Emergency Management funding that has been provided to include DOI All Hazard Emergency Responders in IQCS. The inclusion of DOI All Hazard responders requires the purchase and maintenance of additional PeopleSoft licenses and additional support costs for IQCS. The Rebaseline also includes the new requirement to add the Certification and Accreditation costs at the project level. Previously these costs were captured at the program level and were not included as a direct project cost.


