- To develop biomass energy research and analysis that enables sound investment and policy decisions


















Membership Map

Midwest

- Re-launch of WI's "Focus on Energy" Program, features biomass heating grants
- O Heating the Midwest organizes first conference, management, developing "Vision" for region





West

- California promotes small scale (<3MW) biomass installations in RPS carve-out
- O CO's **Sen. Udall**, 'biomass heating helps forest restoration'
- Washington allow thermal energy in voluntary utility program
- Oregon DOE explores district heating with renewable resources, promotes biomass heating resources
- O Federal facilities in Alaska installing biomass heating systems





The Northeast

- Northeast Biomass Thermal Working Group (NEBTWG) enters 3rd year
- Biomass heating presence at regional shows, new markets
- Working Group develops bulk pellet delivery and storage recommendations
- Major state-specific developments...





New York


- O New state energy plan in 2013
- \$350K NYSERDA Biomass Heating Roadmap
- O RGGI funds for demonstration projects
- O Potential additional NYSERDA funds for Model Neighborhood Project, other demo projects, bulk truck(s)

 New York Biomass Energy
- NYBEA instrumental in all this progress
- NY State Pension Fund investment in pellet plant (Biomaxx)



Maine


- O Focus of \$11 million USDA ARRA demonstration projects (22 chip and pellet systems in 15 buildings)
- 200+ pellet/chip boilers in 3 years res/comm
- O Jackson Labs 44 MMBTU/hr wood powder suspension burner (pellets) 1.3 MM gallons #2
- O Gov. LePage public interest in adding thermal to Maine RPS
- Mainers got HUD to formally recognize automated pellet boilers as legit – big step forward
- O Maine Pellet Fuels Assn active in all




Maine Pellet Fuels



Vermont



- O Pellet boiler \$1000 rebate (from ARRA funds, currently seeking long-term \$ support)
- 2011 Comprehensive Energy Plan put strong emphasis on thermal
- 2012 energy legislation directs state to develop a "whole energy standard" to include thermal incentives
- Boiler regs allow non-ASME biomass boilers





Massachusetts

- O Biomass thermal and CHP have "benefited" to some degree from anti-biomass electric focus
- O DOER study of renewable thermal energy options with focus on biomass/GSHP
- O DOER ARRA grants to Sandri (trucks, 16 C/I systems, residential rebate) and Mass MoCA project
- \$3 million incentive program to be announced soon (residential pellet boiler rebates, woodstove changeout, commercial demo projects - APS compliance \$)
- O Legislature passed energy bill this summer including **DOER study of adding thermal to APS**



Maryland



- O Pilot rebate program, wood and pellet appliances good start that will build support for more \$\$
- RPS gains for thermal technologies including chicken litter (biomass!)
- OMD Dept. of Environment progress on addressing ambiguous regulation of biomass emissions
- Wood Energy Coalition conference November 14 in Annapolis!



New Hampshire

- ARRA-funded pellet boiler rebate 104 systems; now seeking RPS \$\$ to continue for both residential and commercial
- Berlin Model Neighborhood Project 40 buildings
- O Boiler regs allow non-ASME biomass boilers
- ARRA, RGGI and RPS funds for >15 C/I biomass heating projects
- 2012 thermal added to RPS on energy equivalent basis; effective in 2013. Up to \$63 million in RECs by 2025



Translating to Federal Level

- O Pending & Progress
 - Extension of credit for biomass stoves
 - Bipartisan ITC for commercial equipment (S. 3352)
 - Farm Bill Energy Title (grants, payments, CWEP, etc)
 - Thermal inclusion in RES, CES, or other energy framework
 - Recognition by DOE, EPA, USDA, and WH
